BANK ROBBERY UPDATE - SUSPECT IN CUSTODY

On July 10, 2014 at approximately 2:45 p.m., Plano Police Officers obtained a warrant and with the assistance of the United States Marshal Joint East Texas Fugitive Task Force, arrested a suspect in connection with the Bank Robbery. The suspect was identified as Daniel Joseph Allyn, a 19-year old male from Frisco, TX. He is currently being held on a \$100,000 bond.

The investigation remains on-going.



BANK ROBBERY

On July 7, 2014 at approximately 2:45 p.m., Plano Police Officers responded to a Bank Robbery incident in 5900 block of West Parker Road.

Upon Officers arrival, it was determined that the suspect had entered the location, passed a note to the clerk demanding money. The teller complied with the suspects request and the suspect fled the location on foot in an unknown direction of travel.

The suspect was described as a white male, approximately 18-22 years of age, 5'5" - 5'6" in height, and had a heavy build. He had curly brown or red hair, acne, displayed a nervous demeanor, had a strong body odor, and wore glasses. He was last seen wearing a dark-blue patterned polo-style shirt, dark pants, white shoes and a brown and green baseball cap featuring an unknown logo. Surveillance photographs of the suspect are attached to this release.
