

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

PROJECT:

Bob Woodruff Park

What work is being planned at Bob Woodruff Park South?

This project working to evaluate and identify potential locations for the restroom to be replaced. This will include flood plain analysis and surveying work. This planning project is expected to be completed in the Fall of 2020.

What work is being planned at Bob Woodruff Park North?

This project is a planning effort that will evaluate and identify potential renovations and replacements for the restroom, playground, trails and pond edge. This will include flood plain analysis and surveying work. This planning project is expected to be completed in the Fall of 2020.

What can I expect to see?

During this project you can expect to see survey crews measuring the site periodically. They will flag trees and install wood stakes. The trees are only flagged for the purpose of survey and the creation of a planning document. Those flags will be removed. There may also be drones used to provide aerial images and additional survey information.

Can I still use the Parks and Trails?
